SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

Athletic Booster Association Scholarship

Scholarships are determined by the Athletic Office and are based on academic, athletic and leadership ability.

Eleanor and Donald Bierley Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is given in memory of Eleanor Bierley to financially assist a graduating senior of Miamisburg High School who plans to major in business, accounting or finance. Eleanor was a

graduate of Miamisburg High School where she was salutatorian of the class. She worked at the Miami Valley Production Credit Association for many years before ultimately spending time as a homemaker, mother and grandmother. She was also the secretary of the Miamisburg Schools Education Foundation for several years. Applicants must have a minimum G.P.A. of 3.0, plan to major in business, accounting or finance, and demonstrate leadership skills and school involvement.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

Class of 1945

The Miamisburg High School Class of 1945 has created a scholarship fund for graduating seniors. To qualify for this scholarship, seniors must have a demonstrated financial need and a minimum of a 2.5 G.P.A.

Class of 1951 Matthews/Heistand Scholarship

Waldo Matthews was a former head football and basketball coach (at the same time). Matthews' basketball teams went to the regional finals and won several MVL football titles. Lester "Red" Heistand was a Miamisburg graduate who played football, basketball and baseball for Miamisburg and later was football and tennis coach at Miamisburg High School. Award recipients must have an established need, a minimum of a 2.0 G.P.A. and the application must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation. Preference will be given to working students and/or athletes/students involved in extra-curricular activities.

Class of 1962

In honor of their 50th Class Reunion in 2012, the Miamisburg Class of 1962 Scholarship was established to financially assist graduating seniors of Miamisburg High School who are planning on pursuing further education at a college or university. The applicants for this scholarship must plan to attend a two- or four-year college or university, demonstrate a strong work ethic and have a grade point average between 2.5 and 3.5 on a 4.0 scale. Preference will be given to students who demonstrate financial need and are dependents of active duty military families.

Dr. Jane Chance Education Scholarship

Dr. Jane Chance was a teacher, principal and former Assistant

Superintendent for the Miamisburg Schools. The Jane Chance Education Scholarship was created to support graduating seniors attending Miami University and/or pursuing a degree in education. Students must have an excellent academic record and evidence of community service.

Richard C. (Dick) Church, Jr. Scholarship Award

A graduate of Miamisburg High School and a life-long citizen of his home town, no civic leader in the Greater Miamisburg/Miami Township Community has contributed more positives to the school district over the last quarter of a century than has Mayor Richard C. (Dick) Church, Jr. Through the awarding of this scholarship, it is hoped that other Miamisburg City Schools graduates will be so inclined to emulate Dick Church's passion for civic and educational service, and will contribute accordingly. Criteria for selection include pursuing a course of study with majors and minors in public administration, business, humanities, or social sciences (such as history, political science, economics, etc.).

Ray and Shirley Cluxton Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is given in memory of Ray Cluxton to financially assist graduating seniors of Miamisburg High School who have chosen business/finance as their major and who are planning to further their education at an accredited college or university. To continue the spirit of Ray Cluxton's character, students must not only exhibit academic success with a minimum 3.0 G.P.A. but also show a strong commitment to the community with a minimum of 25 hours of service.

Ruth Conner Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is given in memory of Ruth Conner, former counselor at Miamisburg High School. Priority is given to a student who exemplifies the characteristics of integrity and academic excellence.

Dempsey Award

The Dempsey Award was established to financially assist graduating seniors of Miamisburg High School who have demonstrated leadership qualities and have a minimum 3.0 G.P.A.

Connie Doty Nursing Scholarship

This scholarship will be given to a graduating senior who is pursuing a career in nursing. The applicant must have a minimum 3.0 G.P.A., have 2 letters of recommendation and a minimum of 25 hours of community service in their senior year. The scholarship was named as a tribute to Connie Doty, who was vice president for hospital operations at the Children's Hospital Medical Center in Dayton. She has served as president of the Ohio Organization of Nurse Executives, the chair of the Ohio Patient Safety Institute's Education committee, and as a leader in the Dayton Organization of Nurse Executives. In 2002, Mrs. Doty was awarded the American Organization of Nurse Executives Community Partnership Award, for her involvement as chair of the committee charged with designing and constructing the Ronald McDonald House. Connie Doty was the mother of two Miamisburg students, Ryan and Todd and the wife of Jerry Doty.

Todd E. Doty Memorial Golf Scholarship

This scholarship is given in memory of Todd E. Doty, a former MHS golf team member. Not only did Todd make an outstanding contribution to the golf team, he was an honor student who consistently exhibited leadership qualities among the MHS students. The award recipient(s) must be a member of the MHS golf team, have a minimum 2.5 G.P.A. and reflect the qualities exhibited by Todd.

Dr. Clifford Gebhart Scholarship

This scholarship was created to assist graduates of Miamisburg High School who are planning to major in the medical field at a college or university. Scholarship recipients must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in the medical field and have a minimum 3.5 G.P.A.

Carole Grant Memorial Scholarship Fund

This fund was developed to assist graduating seniors who plan to further their education in a college or university preferably in the field of education. Criteria for selection include G.P.A. (3.0 minimum), leadership and school involvement.

Madolin Elizabeth and Sid Hagan Athletic Scholarship

The Madolin Elizabeth and Sid Hagan Athletic Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has earned a minimum of a 3.5 G.P.A. and lettered in at least one sport.

Zinny Harding Memorial Scholarship

Zinny Harding was an English as a Second Language teacher and volunteer in the Miamisburg Schools for ten years. She worked with students

and their families to help them adapt to living in America. This scholarship for a graduating Miamisburg High School senior was established by her friends and family to honor her dedication to helping others. Applicants must plan to major in the areas of social work or education; preference will be given to those planning to major in teaching English as a Second Language, plan to attend a four-year college or university and demonstrate financial need.

Hieronymus Scholarship

This fund was developed to assist students entering the field of education. Criteria for selection include G.P.A. (3.0 minimum), leadership and school involvement.

The Alex Holtzman Memorial Scholarship

The Alex Holtzman Memorial Scholarship was established by family and friends to honor the memory of this 17-year old Miamisburg student. The scholarship will assist graduating seniors of MHS who are pursuing a post secondary education. To qualify for this scholarship, seniors must have a minimum 3.0 G.P.A. The award recipient must have participated in a Mathematics Honors Program at MHS for a two-year period, demonstrated service through community or church activities, participated in the Miamisburg City Youth Baseball/Softball Association program and plan to attend a two or four-year college or university or technical school on a full or part-time basis.

Eldora Joseph Scholarship Fund

The Eldora Joseph Scholarship is established in memory of Eldora Joseph, who began her teaching career in a one-room schoolhouse in Tarlton, OH. Eldora taught grades 1-4 in a K-12 building. She was a career educator who loved learning

her entire life. The applicant must be a student who has a minimum 3.0 G.P.A. and is excited about education, gaining skills and discipline, seeing work through to completion and experiencing genuine satisfaction in that work regardless of the final grade.

Marlene McIntyre Scholarship

The Marlene McIntyre scholarship is awarded to a student who participated in a Miamisburg Tech Prep program. To be awarded a scholarship, a student must be in good academic standing and exhibit leadership qualities either by example or action.

Miamisburg Eagles Aerie 2306 Scholarship

The Fraternal Order of Eagles is an international non-profit organization uniting fraternally in the spirit of liberty, truth, justice, and equality, to make human life more desirable by lessening its ills and promoting peace, prosperity, gladness and hope. The Miamisburg Eagles Aerie 2306 is offering a scholarship to a graduating Miamisburg High School senior who has a minimum 3.0 G.P.A., financial need and has participated in some community service.

Miamisburg Schools Elementary PTA/PTO Scholarships

The Miamisburg Schools Elementary PTO Scholarships (Bauer, Bear, Chance, Kinder, Mark Twain, Medlar View and Mound) were created by each elementary building. Graduating seniors will be eligible if they have attended the majority of their elementary years at that particular school. The scholarships will be based on financial need and enrollment and acceptance in a 2 or 4 year college/university.

Jansen Myers Memorial Grant & Scholarship Fund

This grant/scholarship is to provide funds to the Miamisburg City Schools and Athletics Programs, as well as district staff development on child abuse.

National Honor Society Scholarship

The Miamisburg Chapter of the National Honor Society celebrated its 96th year in 2018. The National Honor Society Scholarship was established many years ago to assist graduating Miamisburg High School seniors who are pursuing post secondary education. Applicants must have been an active NHS member for 2 years; have a minimum 3.5 G.P.A.; show verification of 30 or more recorded hours of community volunteerism; and provide two letters of recommendation.

Jim O'Donnel Wrestling Scholarship

Jim O'Donnel was a teacher and wrestling/football coach for Miamisburg in the 1970's. This fund was established to assist a wrestler in pursuing a higher education and whose character, pride, hard work and drive for success would best represent Jim O'Donnel's beliefs. The O'Donnel Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior wrestler who is an academic achiever with a minimum 3.0 G.P.A. and will be pursuing a higher education.

Jenna Parlette Memorial Scholarship

The ideal candidate will embody the spirit of Jenna Parlette. Jenna's smile spoke a thousand words as she was always there to support others and assist them in overcoming obstacles in their lives. Applicants must submit an essay that briefly describes a time when they had an impact on a friend, teammate, fellow competitor,

classmate or acquaintance by helping them overcome an obstacle or by supporting them in some manner.

Elena Perry "Grandma Alt" Swimming Scholarship

This scholarship was established in 2011 to honor Elena Perry for her support of her two grandsons, Nicholas and Brandon Alt, during their swimming careers at Miamisburg High School. Elena was present at almost every swim meet during the five years they swam and was known to cheer on every swimmer on the team. She was instrumental in establishing the first scholarship given through MHS Swim Boosters. This scholarship will financially assist graduating MHS seniors who have participated in the swim program and who will be furthering their education at a two- or four- year college of their choice. Students must also have a minimum 2.5 G.P.A., a minimum three years of participation on the swim team and must swim as a senior.

Helen Reed Scholarship

The Helen Reed Scholarship Fund was created in January 2000 from Helen Reed's estate as a legacy to her dedication to Miamisburg Schools and the Miamisburg School Community. This scholarship will provide assistance for post-secondary education to students who might not otherwise receive financial assistance. To maintain the spirit of Helen Reed's character, students will need to show evidence of community involvement (in school activities or outside activities) and must have been a student in Miamisburg City Schools for at least 8 years.

Retired Miamisburg School Employees Scholarship

This scholarship is given to seniors who choose post-secondary education. Students who are selected must have a successful academic history in high school and a minimum 3.0 G.P.A.

Schmidt Family Scholarship

This scholarship was created by Frederick and Michael Schmidt in memory of their mother and father, Herman J. and Margaret J. Schmidt. Scholarship criteria includes a 3.0 G.P.A. and the pursuit of a career in music. Mrs. Schmidt was a trained vocalist and pianist and a founder of the Vivace Music Club where she was a member from 1927 to 2004.

Benny Smith Fund

The Benny Smith Fund has been established for the express purpose of providing athletic equipment or supplies that are needed but not provided by the Miamisburg High School Athletic Department to Miamisburg High School athletes who need financial assistance to purchase athletic equipment or supplies.

The Robert E. and Audrey E. Stachler Scholarship

The Stachler Scholarship in memory of Robert E. and Audrey E. Stachler was created through funds bequeathed to the Miamisburg Schools Education Foundation by Audrey in her will. It was her wish to create a scholarship in her and her husband's memory. Audrey was a member of the Miamisburg High School class of 1924. The scholarship to be given annually to a graduating senior is based on responsibility, citizenship and moral character. This scholarship is open to all college bound students as well as technical or vocational school bound students.

Templer Award Fund

This award is given to a senior boy or girl earning 5 career varsity letters, one team sport and one individual sport during his/her senior year. The student must have a 3.0 G.P.A. and a letter from a coach attesting to good conduct. If no one qualifies, no award will be given.

Dr. Ray Terrell Scholarship

This scholarship is given to seniors who meet the following criteria: active participation in activities and organizations that are directly related to supporting or developing diversity in Miamisburg Schools and/or community; academic achievement including G.P.A.; demonstration of good citizenship; and financial need.

Bill Toadvine Memorial Baseball Scholarship

The Bill Toadvine Scholarship is named for the science teacher and coach who dedicated 17 years to Miamisburg Schools. Bill was Freshman Baseball coach from 1972-1975, Varsity Assistant Coach from 1976-1977 and Varsity Baseball Coach from 1978-1988, where he compiled a .548 record (149 wins/123 losses) during his tenure as Head Baseball Coach. Bill and his teams distinguished themselves with MCC Championships in 1980 and 1981, MML Championships in 1983, 1984 and 1987 as well as District Championships in 1981 and 1984. His performance and excellence as a coach earned him MML Coach of the Year in 1983, 1984 and 1987. Interested applicants must have lettered in baseball for at least two years and plan to go to college. Included in this fund agreement are funds for baseball field improvements. Donors who wish to contribute to this part of the fund should specify so.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

Visual Arts Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the K-12 Art staff of Miamisburg City Schools to honor and financially support graduating seniors of Miamisburg High School. Applicants must have demonstrated strong skills and creativity in visual arts. Applicants must plan to pursue a career in the visual arts as they continue their post-secondary education. Recipients will have attended MHS for a minimum of three years, must have taken Art I, II, III, and IV, maintained an overall 3.0 G.P.A and a minimum 3.5 G.P.A. for all art classes.

Joanna Weglage Scholarship

This scholarship is given to a deserving clarinet or winter guard senior with a G.P.A. of 3.0 or better. Students must show an attitude of dedication, commitment and enthusiasm to the program and will be chosen with the assistance of the Band Director and/or Winter Guard Director.

Dave Wood Scholarship

This scholarship is given in memory of Dave Wood, an outstanding educator in the Miamisburg Schools. The recommended criteria for a student to receive this scholarship are that he/she have average to above average grades and test scores, financial need and commute to Miami University Middletown, Wright State University or the University of Dayton.

Jayne Wysong Memorial Scholarship

The family and friends of Jayne Wysong established this scholarship in 2013 in memory of this Miamisburg High School graduate. Jayne was a lifelong resident of Miamisburg who loved her hometown. She was a beloved volunteer at the Miamisburg Senior Adult Center, an avid supporter of the Miamisburg Viking Boosters, and a true blue Viking to the end. The scholarship is being offered to a graduating senior of Miamisburg High School who plans to attend a Division III college or university and participate in an intercollegiate sport. Applicants must also have a minimum G.P.A. of 2.75, participate in extra-curricular activities and demonstrate a community service record.

Lisa Zimmerman Memorial Scholarship

Lisa "Shorty" Zimmerman, a 2002 graduate of Miamisburg High School was active in dance, cheerleading, sports and student government. This award celebrates her life by awarding a scholarship to a female student who also participated in cheerleading and/or student government, maintained a "B" average and has exhibited a spirit of enthusiasm and leadership skills while at MHS.



GRANT & SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

College Prep Challenge Scholarship

The College Prep Challenge Scholarship was established to financially assist graduating seniors of Miamisburg High School who have challenged themselves academically through their senior year and who are planning to further their education at an accredited college or university. Interested applicants must have a minimum 3.0 G.P.A. and have been enrolled in a demanding curriculum through their senior year.

Teacher Mini-Grant Program

The generous contributions of Dempsey Industries, Lee Hieronymus, Farmers & Merchants Bank as well as funds generated from the General Endowment Fund and Miscellaneous Activities Fund, support the annual Teacher Mini-Grant Program.

Vocational Scholarships

The Miamisburg Schools Education Foundation sponsors two types of "Vocational" Scholarships. The first scholarship for tool kits or work clothing is to be used to support the training of 10th grade students who might otherwise not consider the training because of the initial investment.

The second type of Vocational Scholarship is designed to support graduating seniors entering the workplace or those who choose to further their education in a trade school.

The Foundation also awards three College Prep Challenge Scholarships that support and reward students who have challenged themselves by taking a demanding curriculum through their senior year and maintained a 3.0 G.P.A.

MINI GRANTS AWARDED

Each year the Foundation awards grants to foster and advance the quality of instruction in Miamisburg classrooms. Projects represent a unique opportunity for teachers to enhance learning possibilities for Miamisburg students.

The Miamisburg Schools Education Foundation also awards scholarships to seniors as they extend their education beyond high school. Our goal for the year 2019 is to increase the number of scholarships and the amount of the awards to the class of 2019.
