

PARENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE (PAC) FOR FEDERAL GRANTS & SPECIAL EDUCATION

Miamisburg City Schools has a Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) for Federal Grants and Special Education. The committee is made up of parents of Miamisburg students who are served by a program funded through federal grants and/or a special education program. The committee meets quarterly to discuss district news, federal grant updates, special education updates, and upcoming events both at the local and state level.

For the 2017-18 school year the meetings are scheduled on September 11, 2017, November 13, 2017, February 12, 2018. All meetings are held at the Memorial Building at 1:00 PM. The last meeting will be held on April 19th, 2018 at 5:30pm prior to the Board of Education Meeting at the Civic Center. The purpose of the meeting is to seek public input on the expenditures of the district's Federal Grant and IDEA funds. Interested parents are welcome to attend all meetings. Members of the PAC are always available to support other parents in the district. Often the networking during the meeting will help other parents learn of new community resources. The PAC committee also supports the Viking Adapted Athletic program.
